Atomic Bomb Survivor, and their assistants.


This exhibition is an attempt to introduce artworks linked to astrological concepts.

Art reflects the thoughts of the artist and the mood of the times.

Astrology, on the other hand, is a study that tries to grasp the world by the movement and arrangement of stars.

The Sun, Moon, Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto are important planets in astrology because they move greatly among other stars.

Each planet has its own characteristics such as "ego / your self-esteem" for the sun and "thinking / communication" for Mercury.



This exhibition focuses on the common point that art and astrology deal with property of human beings and Social trends, and will introduce about 60 contemporary art pieces, mainly paintings, photographs and sculptures.


6km from Hagi-Iwami Airport (Airport Bus to JR Masuda Station, 15 minutes)
